1.Red Skelton Museum of American Comedy .20 Red Skelton Blvd. (GPS use: 100 W. Portland Ave.) Open till 5:00 pm on Saturday The Red Skelton Museum of American Comedy celebrates the life and legacy of one of America's greatest comedians. This 3,500 square foot, fully interactive museum focuses on Red's life.



2. Grouseland, President William Henry Harrison Mansion .3 West Scott Street | Vincennes, IN. 47591 Open Saturday till 5:00pm. Grouseland was the home of William Henry Harrison,

then governor of the Indiana territory, later ninth president of the United States.



3. George Rogers Clark National Historical Park

.401 South 2nd Street | Vincennes. Open Sunday at 9:00am. Must watch the "Long Knives" 30 min movie on the historic events of George Rogers Clark who was a daring frontier leader helping the United States secure the vast Northwest Territory during the American Revolution.



4. Indiana Military Museum

.715 S. Sixth Street | Vincennes, IN. 47591 Open Sunday 11:00 am The Indiana Military Museum has an outstanding display of the Civil War through WWI, WWII, Korea, Vietnam, Desert Storm, and current engagements. The Annex exhibit space displays feature tanks, artillery, and aircraft; while the indoor museum showcases uniforms, flags, battlefield relics, captured enemy souvenirs, WWII toys, home front items, and vehicles.
